What is the NTLPCorp Fellows Program?

The NTLPCorp Fellows Program is a transformative year-long program that integrates the leadership skills students obtain at camp and utilize those skills to create a service project that impacts their community directly.

Who are NTLPCorp Fellows?

NTLP Fellows are future community leaders and agents of change. They embrace and execute NTLP's core values, make a year-long commitment to represent NTLP and work with mentors and other Fellows to identify problems or needs to improve their community.

This year, NTLP will identify two students who will serve as our NTLPCorp Fellows for 2016. At the completion of their fellowship, he/she will receive a \$2,500 scholarship to the college of their choice. Scholarships will be based on the extent of the project proposed and awarded upon the project's completion.

Qualifications to apply:

- Applicants must be juniors, seniors or incoming college freshmen for Fall 2016.
- All applicants must attend one of the two NTLP camps in Summer 2016.
- Application must be complete, typed and submitted electronically or by mail.
- Applications **MUST** be postmarked by August 12, 2016. Late applications will not be accepted.

Requirements of NTLPCorp Fellows:

- Attend a NTLP Summer Camp in 2016.
- Design and implement a community service project to be completed by June 30, 2017.
- Present their community service project.
- Fulfill all other requirements of the NTLPCorp Fellow program.
