THE INTERVIEW - (All Students should submit interview questions) Return no later than- **June 27, 2010.**

All students will have a one-on-one interview with a business professional. The answers to your questions below will be given to the judges so they can learn more about you. These answers are not graded. Scores for the Interview are not based on knowledge, grades or accumulation of activities. The interview is based on communication skills, confidence, poise, personality and overall presence. All participants will receive a written assessment of their interview from the judges.



On a separate piece of paper, type:

INTERVIEW, followed by your Name, High School & Year of High School Graduation

Briefly answer the three questions below, using no more than 50-75 words per question. This is not an essay contest. Simply answer the questions honestly and completely, but great detail is not necessary. This is just so the judges can learn a little bit more about you and provide them with topics of discussion.

- 1) If you had the chance to spend a million dollars on anything BUT yourself, how would you spend it?
- 2) What's the best thing about being a teen? What is the worst?
- 3) What's the one thing in your life that you would want to do differently?

Please type or use a computer. If this is not possible, please PRINT in capitals and as clearly and legibly as possible.
